**Foothills Medical Centre Area Communities Working Group (ACWG)**

Nothing to report.

**FMC Powerplant**

There was release of high pressure from the powerplant at about 4:30 am on June 27<sup>th</sup>. FMC indicated this was a result of repairs that are ongoing. Another release (3 shorts releases within about 30 min.) occurred around 12:30 am on Aug 14<sup>th</sup>. Al is following up with his contacts to discover why this happened. The releases are very loud and disruptive to the surrounding communities.

**FMC Master Planning Engagement Working Group**

This group is meeting regularly on Friday afternoons so Jacques and Ken have replaced Liz on this committee.

**Calgary Cancer Project**

The Notley government has indicated the Cancer Centre will be on the Foothills site and they are considering 2 potential locations.

**Western Securities - Stadium Shopping Centre**

Nothing to update – a development permit should be submitted soon for the site.

**West Campus Development**

The street naming application was approved by the City in July. A request for proposal for a hotel consultant was released on August 10 to look at the feasibility of offering hotel services on the site.

**Crowchild Trail Corridor Study**
